Dear Parishioners:

Today we will have an opportunity to honour our fallen veterans at the end of the 9:30 a.m. Mass. It is a small gesture of respect and remembrance, but one that could never repay the ultimate sacrifice paid by our heroic men and women. We owe them a debt of gratitude and deep admiration. The brunt of their sacrifices has also been borne by their families and loved ones. We owe them our gratitude and respect as well.

This year will mark a special Remembrance Day being the 100th Anniversary of the First Remembrance Day that was inaugurated at the end of World War I (1918) at the 11th hour of the 11th day and 11th month.

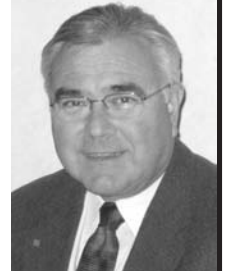
