

Well Done Good and Trustworthy Servant

The Gospel reading of today (Matthew 25:14-30) presents us with the parable of the talents. The servants who received five and two talents respectively showed they could be trusted, and through hard work produced more talents for the Master. They are recognized: "Well done good and faithful servant...enter into the joy of your master." On the other hand, the servant who received one talent squandered the opportunity and received the rebuke of his master.

Of all the servants, with whom do I identify the most? Do I try to put into practice my talents and gifts? Do I show generosity towards the community and towards those who need it? In the language of good stewardship, we speak of the 3 Ts: time, talent and treasure. It's our way of giving back to the community. Here are some concrete suggestions to consider when asking ourselves if I am a faithful servant and steward for the community and for God's Kingdom:

- Offering my service as a minister at Mass such as a Lector or Minister of Communion
- Joining one of our service groups who do outreach in the greater community, such as the St. Vincent de Paul, CWL or Knights of Columbus
- Offering my assistance with our Hall activities which is an important source of income for the parish
- Offering to do clean-up after our coffee socials on Sunday
- Offering my assistance with our programs directed toward our young people
- Dedicating more time to prayer at home or in Church, aside from the Sunday Mass
- Praying and reflecting over my Sunday offering...am I able to provide 5% of my annual income as part of my contribution through the use of envelopes or the Electronic Bank Fund Transfer?
