

Being Good Stewards

As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace (1 Peter 4:10)

Dear Parishioners:

Last week I spoke to you about stewardship. Stewardship means giving back to the community through the 3 Ts: Time, Talent, and Treasure. As I mentioned, we are happy to serve you and provide a place to celebrate and receive the sacraments and continue our mission of being a welcoming community. However, our mission and ministry depend on you. A good barometer of giving is one hour of your work week (in your job or at home). Below I provide you with concrete ways you can be good stewards for our community of Blessed Sacrament and St. Anthony Daniel:

Time: How much time do I invest praying for my community or for any special intentions of my fellow parishioners? How much time do I invest serving my community as a volunteer or member of our church groups, like St. Vincent de Paul, CWL, Knights of Columbus, Ministries, Health and Safety Team?

Talent: Do I put my God-given talents at the service of my community? Can I offer my service for small odds and ends, like cleaning, repairing, washing our altar linens? Is there a new project I can undertake on behalf of my community?

Treasure: Do I consistently give week after week, support for the community and for our outreach to the poor (St. Vincent de Paul)? Can I offer the equivalent of one hour of my work week (at a job or at home) on a weekly basis? Have I considered a legacy gift to the Parish in my Will? As we approach the last year of our Capital Campaign, One Heart, One Soul, have I made my regular pledged contributions? If I did not participate, can I make a one-time commitment so that we can undertake the last phase of our goals, such as paying down our debt and making improvements to the Church/Hall buildings?

Finally, I want to recognize that we do have very generous parishioners who give of their time, talent and treasure week after week. Thank you for your example of generosity, service and love of our community. May your good example inspire all of us!
