





It is a day that commemorates both known and unknown Saints who have acquired Heaven There was a time when many Roman Emperors persecuted Christians, thus leading to the death of several martyrs. Today Christians continue to be prosecuted as well. In Nigeria specifically, and throughout other parts of the world.

It was also a time when the Church kept aside several days for honoring martyrs. Pope Boniface IV formally started the celebration of All Saints' Day in the seventh century in honor of all the Saints at the same time.

### All Souls Day November 2<sup>nd</sup>

All Souls' Day, also known as the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed and the Day of the Dead, is a day of prayer and remembrance for the faithful departed. On All Souls Day, we not only remember the dead, but we apply our efforts, through prayer, almsgiving, and the Mass, to their release from Purgatory.
