Understanding the Mass – Why Does it Sound This Way? When the Church decided to translate the Latin Missal into English, experts in Latin, liturgy, English, poetry, music and translation, as well as other disciplines, were consulted to produce the best translation possible. After thirty years of experience with the last translation, we saw that we had lost some important content by loosely paraphrasing the Latin prayers into English. The Missal now has the most accurate translation of the Latin prayers, and it is closest to what the Church prayed for centuries. Sometimes the translators had to use words or phrases that sound more formal or 'old fashioned' because that was the most accurate way to keep the original meaning. But almost all of the translations were able to balance a good, accurate translation with simple and dignified language and a Roman 'style' of prayer that help us to remember that we are speaking to God who is deserving of all of our love and respect.
