Sunday Reflection:

"A voice cries out: In the wilderness prepare the way of the LORD..." We typically don't think of Advent as a wilderness experience, do we? The Israelites encountered the Lord in the wilderness of the desert during their Exodus journey from slavery in Egypt to the Promised Land. Their pilgrimage through it is an image of the journey we each make through this life to God's kingdom. Both are journeys where we have an idea of the destination but not how long it will take, nor do we have an exact GPS route from here to there. Advent is our pilgrimage towards Christmas.

Understanding the Mass – "And With Your Spirit?" "The Lord be with you" and the response, "and with your spirit", echo St. Paul's conclusion in his letters to the Galatians and to Timothy (Gal 6:18 and 2 Tim 4:22). This greeting is used 4 times during Mass. The celebrant uses it at the beginning of Mass, during the Preface Dialogue before the Eucharistic Prayer and at the End of Mass. The deacon uses it (or in his absence the priest) before the Gospel. "Spirit" signifies the spirit given to the bishop, priest or deacon at his ordination for service to the Church. The greeting and response help us to remember that the Holy Spirit empowers the celebration of the sacraments in which God blesses, heals, forgives, strengthens and nourishes us. Fr Geoff
