Reflection for Lent:

Lent is kind of like the spiritual equivalent of spring cleaning. Each spring we go through our stuff, decide what to keep, what to donate to a worthy cause and what to throw away. When we just keep accumulating stuff, not only do we begin to run out of room to store it, we also tend to forget what good stuff we actually already have. Lent is the time when we take careful stock of where we are in our relationship with God and with others. There are three things the Church encourages us to do in Lent: pray, fast and give alms (ie give to charity). We all know that we need to pray if we want to experience God's grace in our lives but we often forget about the other two things we can do in Lent. The practice of giving up something we like during Lent reminds us of Christ's supreme act of self-sacrifice on the Cross for our salvation. Our token sacrifice of, for example, dessert at dinner or a favourite TV program or video game, also helps build up our willpower too - if I can say no to something I enjoy, it gives me practice in saying no to things I shouldn't have or do. By giving alms to charity, we call to mind the many ways God has blessed us with material security and we are reminded also that God expects us to share our blessings with others. 
