March is the Month of St. Joseph: we have a tradition in the Church of honouring St. Joseph during this month. His feast day is March 19th, which often falls in Lent but we take a 'break' from Lent on that day to honour this holy man. He has many titles in the Church and there is a long history of devotion to the foster father and guardian of Jesus, the husband of Mary, the protector of the Holy Family, patron of a good death, the Patron of the Universal Church. Here is a prayer for your use from the 1st Century of the Church:

Prayer to St. Joseph: Oh, St. Joseph, whose protection is so great, so prompt, so strong, before the throne of God, I place in you all my interests and desires. Oh, St. Joseph, do assist me by your powerful intercession, and obtain for me from your Divine Son all spiritual blessings, through Jesus Christ, our Lord. So that, having engaged here below your heavenly power, I may offer my thanksgiving and homage to the most Loving of Fathers. Oh, St. Joseph, I never weary contemplating you and Jesus asleep in your arms; I dare not approach while He reposes near your heart. Press Him in my name and kiss His fine Head for me and ask Him to return the Kiss when I draw my dying breath. St. Joseph, Patron of departed souls — pray for me. Amen.

Understanding the Mass - Behold the Lamb of God: At the "Invitation to Communion," the priest shows the consecrated host to the people and says: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those who are called to the supper of the Lamb." These words echo the words of John the Baptist to his disciples when he identified Jesus as "the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world" (John 1:29 and see also John 1:36). These words also remind us of the Book of Revelation where John reports the angel saying to him: "Blessed are those who have been called to the wedding feast of the Lamb" (Rev: 19:9). The people's response repeats, with one change, the words of the Roman centurion in Luke's Gospel when he asked Jesus to cure his servant: "Lord I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my servant [we say instead "my soul"] shall be healed" (cf. Luke 7: 6-7). The Lord, the Lamb of God who takes away our sin, does truly come to us in the Eucharist, because of His great love. Fr. Geoff


