#### **Reflection:**

Today is the last Sunday in Ordinary Time - the Feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. In the preface before the Eucharistic Prayer today we pray: "For you [God the Father] anointed your Only Begotten Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, with the oil of gladness as eternal Priest and King of all creation, so that, by offering himself on the altar of the Cross as a spotless sacrifice to bring us peace, he might accomplish the mysteries of human redemption, and, making all created things subject to his rule, he might present to the immensity of your majesty an eternal and universal kingdom, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace." The kingdom of God is unique because Christ's kingship is like no other kingship that ever existed in history or fiction.

Understanding the Mass – Where Does Latin Fit In? In the West, the Mother Tongue of the Church has been Latin since the Church was established in Rome. After the Second Vatican Council, the Church gave permission for the Mass to be translated from the official Latin version into other languages with the approval of the Vatican. The Church revised the Mass, making some changes and additions, in an official Latin text that then needed to be translated into other languages. The Englishspeaking world was the first language group to translate the New Missal from the official, original Latin text into another language. The International Commission on English in the Liturgy (ICEL) translated the texts of the Mass from Latin to English. The translation underwent 17 drafts and was scrutinized by eleven English speaking national conferences of bishops. The Catholic Church often continues to produce her official documents in Latin and in this way every language group has a common 'reference text' to use to make sure we are saying and meaning the same things. We still use Latin (and one Greek response) in our Mass periodically to remind us of our Latin, Roman Catholic identity and as a witness to a faith stretching back centuries. An interesting fact: over eighty percent of the prayers we use today date back to before the ninth century! Latin will not replace English as the language in which we celebrate Mass on Sunday but understanding its importance as the 'core' or original language of the Roman Catholic Church is helpful.
