### **Gospel Reflection:**

Jesus is making his way to Jerusalem to his crucifixion and death when he meets Bartimaeus. He has told his disciples what he is doing and he will tell them again but they refuse to see what he is doing. There is an irony in this encounter: the blind man sees more clearly than the sighted people. The key to unlocking the significance of today's Gospel is that Jesus turns the phrase "seeing is believing" upside down to "believing is seeing."
