Reflection: Advent begins our journey of spiritual renewal in preparation for Christ. At Advent, we celebrate several ways that Christ comes to fix our broken world. In today's first reading, Jeremiah proclaimed that the Lord would fulfil His promise: "I will make a righteous branch grow up for David and that branch will do what is right and just in the land" (Is 11:1) In today's Gospel, Jesus speaks of His second coming: "Be vigilant at all times and pray that you have the strength to escape the tribulations that are imminent and to stand before the Son of Man" (Lk 21:36). At Advent, we prepare for the coming of Christ into our heart. We must be prepared to give Him the gift of ourselves, which should be holy and pleasing to Him. Thus, today's second reading encourages us to prepare our hearts for Jesus by growing in love and virtue. 'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2024'
