Reflection: The Third Sunday of Advent is traditionally referred to as "Gaudete Sunday". Today's readings invite us to rejoice because the time for the divine visitation is near. The 'tax collector' represents those who buy and sell without scruples, thinking only of their advantage; in their clever deception, they cheat people, evade taxes and take advantage of the naivete of the poor to exploit them and get rich. Anyone who behaves like the 'tax collectors' certainly cannot attain eternal happiness. The 'soldiers' represent those who abuse authority, take advantage of their position and profession to exploit others. Those dominate and over power the weakest behave like 'soldiers' and are invited to review their behaviour if they want to prepare themselves for the coming of the Lord. Coming together to feed our families;


