**Reflection:** With the baptism of the Lord commences the Ordinary Time of the year. Though sinless, Jesus voluntarily approached John for the baptism to show his solidarity with sinful humanity. # OUR CATHOLIC SCHOOLS VIRTUE OF THE MONTH


During the month of January, our Catholic Schools are celebrating the value of **RESPONSIBILITY**.
