Reflection: The gospel of the day combines two separate passages taken from Luke. He begins by establishing the purpose of his Gospel and then goes on to present Jesus' proclamation of his mission. Jesus' intention in reading the passage from the prophet Isaiah was to let his listeners know that God has sent him on a very special mission. He told them exactly what kind of Messiah he would be, and what his mission consisted of. The uncomfortable truths proclaimed by Jesus may not be

pleasing to our ears but as followers today, we have the same mission to carry out. There are many people whom the Good News has still to reach. Several people are waiting to be alleviated and freed from bondages of different types. Above all, we need the anointing of the Holy Spirit to fulfil the mission of Jesus. How shall we be the voices of liberation and witnesses to the liberating work of Jesus in our time? 'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2025.'


