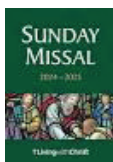

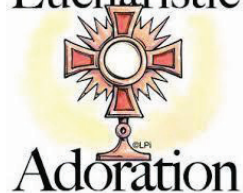


On the Feast of the Epiphany, we learn about the Three Wisemen who followed a star to find Jesus. These men, when they found the Infant

Mass intention cards are available, if you would like to include them in your Christmas cards.

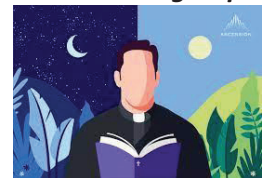


Would you like to read the entire Bible in 2025?
