

#### Adoration Every Wednesday


Adoration and Exposition of The Blessed Sacrament starts at 11:00am, right before the Rosary

Mass request envelopes are available at the entrances of the church or you can contact the parish office.



meetings *Monday, January 6, 2025 at 7pm.*For more information contact Carmen at 705-969-3665




Legion of Mary Meeting holds every Sunday immediately after 10:15am mass, except for Sundays we have Parish breakfast
