**Reflection:** Today's reading from Sirach and Luke's Gospel speak about the power of tongue, the power of speech. They refer to the tongue as a sword and an indicator of health. With our words, we can give comfort, strength, encouragement, praise. We can sing of the glory of God, or hurt, destroy reputations, spread suspicion and slander. Our words can clarify and clear the air. They can also deceive and create confusion. Most of our interaction with the world is through words. The Book of Sirach says in the following chapter after today's reading: Many have fallen by the sword, but many more by the tongue. The tongue is indeed a sword. The tongue is also an indicator of the state of our physical health. "From the fullness of the heart, the mouth speaks." These words tell us how we speak to and about others is a good indicator of what is happening in our hearts. It's time to turn away from trying to remove the splinter from another's eye, and concentrate on getting rid of the wooden beam in our own eye.


