GOOD FRIDAY FAMILY PROMOTION BY FR BRIAN McKEE KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS COUNCIL 1387

Attendance at the Good Friday Liturgy of the Lord's Passion and Death has been in decline in many parts of our country; but we can change this! All Knight of Columbus should plan to attend his parish's liturgy on Good Friday, April 18th bringing wives, children and friends along. Invite other families in our parish to do the same. It is all too easy to look away from the harsh reality that Christ suffered agonizing pain and died on the cross for us. However, our faith — and that of our families and parishes — is strengthened when we take the time to meditate on his Passion and Death. So, this Good Friday, attend the liturgy with your family and transform your parish today.

Reflection: St. Augustine sees in the making of the mud paste a metaphor for the Incarnation: the divine power mixing with the earth, resulting in the formation of a healing balm. The healing of the manis a representation of Christianity as a way of seeing. Jesus makes a mud paste, which he then rubs onto the man's eyes, and instructs him to wash his eyes in the pool of Siloam. His sight was restored. All except the Pharisees are amazed. They accuse the man of being naïve and the healer, a sinner. With simplicity, he responds: "If he is a sinner, I do not know. One thing I do know is that I was blind and now I see." This is exactly what everyone who encounters Christ says. With the ointment of God-made flesh rubbed

onto our eyes blinded by sin, we come again to see. 'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2025'.




