Reflection: Many people cherish portable devices because of their convenience and efficient



utility. Similarly, our Lord Jesus reduced all the commandments of God into the double commandments of love thy God and neighbour. These double commandments are more portable than even the smallest phone, because they don't require a purse or even our hands to carry them. They are carried in the heart.

Therefore, as long as we have a heartbeat, the commandments of love can be used anytime and anywhere. They do not operate on a man-made network which may be interrupted. Besides, they require no man-made data to function, but the free grace of God. Now, while we “communicate” love for God (the Love-Network service provider) through prayer, worship and obedience, let us “communicate love for others through charity, patience, thoughtfulness, etc. This is how we can fulfil all the commandments of God 24x7.
