On a similar note, please note that the weekly (Sunday) showing of "Le Jour du Seigneur" (Radio Canada) will continue as always to provide Sunday Mass at its usual time and channel.

RESOURCES FOR MASS – **PDF**: The CCCB General Secretariat has received word from **Novalis**, Living with Christ and Prions en Église, that during this current health crisis, they are willing to post on their websites PDFs of the pages from Living with Christ and Prions en Église for each upcoming **Sunday Mass**, as well as for **Daily Mass**, so as to allow people to download them for free during this limited period of time.
