Hi Father Brennan,

I received your email with great joy and thanksgiving to God, who has placed his Spirit into your heart, and into the hearts of all the faithful whom God has put into your care.

Three-thousand dollars is a wonderful harvest, may all those who have contributed be repaid 100 fold in the currency of God's infinite love.

At the beginning of this year a good friend of mine, who is a Missionary of Africa working in Nigeria, gave me 6,000 Ghana Cedis making it possible for Lydia to have the operation on her right hip. To his amount I added 3,000 Ghana Cedis of my own to cover any post operative care and physiotherapy. Lydia is now doing well and is living without pain, and like most young people her age who have completed their tertiary education, Lydia is busy looking for a place of employment. So far she has not succeeded in securing a job but she is tenacious and I'm sure she will find something before too long.

When Lydia had the operation on her right hip the doctor told her that her left hip would also, eventually, give her trouble and would need to be operated on. Knowing this, Lydia, since her operation, has been placing whatever little money she gets into a special account for the day when that operation will be necessary. At the moment she has been able to put 1,400 in the account.

The money you have sent me to be given to her, will ensure her a continued pain free future.

Thank you all for your wonderful kindness.

As for myself I am keeping well and busy. The rains this year have been, so far, very poor. Please pray on our behalf that Lord of the harvest will send us what is needed to sustain us throughout the coming year.

May God bless you Fr. Kerry Brennan and may he bless all the good people who are with you.
