## COUNTDOWN TO LENT ASH WEDNESDAY IS COMING!

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the holy season Lent. There will be 9:30 a.m. Mass, with the imposition of Ashes at which time the school communities of St. Joseph's High School and St. Thomas the Apostle School will attend. We will also have Mass at 7:00 p.m. on Ash Wednesday with imposition of Ashes. Lent provides us with an opportunity to do Penance for our sins. During Lent penance is an important requirement of Christian life. Fulfillment of this duty involves prayer, works of piety and charity, and self-denial by fulfilling one's obligations more faithfully and especially by observing the prescribed fast and abstinence. Fridays are days of abstinence from meat, but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and of abstinence from meat. The law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age. The law of abstinence from meat, binds those who are 14 and older.

During Lent we will have Mass at 7:00 p.m. on Mondays preceded by the Stations of the Cross at 6:30 p.m. led by members of the CWL and the K of C. Mass on Tuesdays will be at 9:00 a.m. and Wednesday to Friday at 8:00 a.m. Please make a special effort to come to Mass whenever you can during this Holy Season.

Reconciliation will be available before all weekend Masses and all Fridays before the morning Mass.
