# Frequently Asked Questions

## Q. What is Sign-Up Sunday?

A. Sign-Up Sundays are a series of weekends being held in churches across Ontario with a desire to gather a least one email address from every family. This information will be used at the discretion of our bishop to communicate periodically on issues of significant importance to the Catholic community. The first campaign of 2018 is the Call for Conscience campaign.

### Q. What is the Call for Conscience Campaign?

A. The Call for Conscience campaign (spearheaded by the Coalition for HealthCARE & Conscience) will ask our elected Members of Provincial Parliament (MPPs) and those seeking office this June to increase funding/access to palliative care, to protect health care workers wishing to abstain from any involvement in euthanasia/assisted suicide and to protect faith based facilities from participation in euthanasia/assisted suicide. The work builds on a similar campaign in 2017.


