Further to last week's announcement about MAID

"MAID" IS MURDER

In 2016, the Canadian Government changed the law on euthanasia and assisted suicide to make both legal in certain circumstances. The new policy is now euphemistically referred to as "Medical assistance in dying (MAID)". According to the Justice Department website, the official number of people killed through MAID since 2016 is 6700, but you can be sure the real number is higher.

Since the implementation of MAID, there have been several cases brought against the government stating that certain restrictions are unconstitutional and the law must be less restrictive. One such case, *Truchon v. Attorney General of Canada*, stated that MAID should not be limited to those nearing the end of life. This case prompted the Justice Department to create a questionnaire to poll public opinion on how MAID should be expanded. This poll can be found at: https://www.justice.gc.ca/eng/cons/ad-am/index.html. The poll closes on January 27th.

The trouble with the MAID questionnaire is that it is skewed toward expanding MAID. Apart from three "comment boxes", the questions assume that the respondent agrees with the premise that certain sick people can be killed. The goal of the questionnaire is to find public opinion on the implementation of MAID, rather than the fundamental morality of the policy. This skewed approach makes the questionnaire quite confusing, which is why *Campaign Life Coalition* has prepared an article to assist people in answering the questions: https://www.campaignlifecoalition.com/hot-news/id/508. I encourage you to read the *Campaign Life Coalition* article and to fill out the questionnaire. Given that euthanasia and assisted suicide are now legal, we must do what we can to restrict their use.

"Medical assistance in dying" should refer to palliative care and offering those in need the best possible care; instead, it means killing people when they are most vulnerable. How is killing care? In Canada, prior to June 2016, acts of euthanasia and assisted suicide were acts of homicide, and in most countries they are still considered homicide. The sick and disabled are particularly vulnerable to abuse and manipulation, which means the law should afford special protection to them. "Medical assistance in dying (MAID), is just a nice way to say, "legal murder".

The legalization of euthanasia and assisted suicide by the Trudeau government is leading our country down a very dark road. The implication of the law is that some lives have no dignity or value. Who decides which life is worth living? The initial law placed restrictions to qualify for MAID and now, only four years later, some of those restrictions are being removed. The law undermines the meaning of healthcare by turning killing into "caring" and it forces healthcare professionals into situations where they must choose between losing their job and assisting in murder.

As Catholics, we believe that every life has value and that euthanasia and assisted suicide are always evil. We believe that every person should be loved and cared for right up to their natural death. God bless you, and pray for our country.
