- UPDATE ON SEWER REPLACEMENT: Fulton construction is planning on completing the sewer replacement beginning July 3rd. After exploring all possibilities it has been decided that the front church steps will have to be torn up because the sewer line goes directly under the steps. Because of huge rocks, the sewer line cannot be detoured around the steps. The reason we cut down the spruce tree is the fact that it was the roots of this tree that caused the sewer problems as they invaded the sewer pipe. Because of this construction the front entrance of the church will be closed for approximately 3 weeks.
