MEAL REVENUE - down by \$111.90
MEAL EXPENSES - up by \$197.94
(total of all food, advertising and supplies)
FOOD EXPENSES (beef & vegetables)
- up by \$466.59. About 15 lbs. less beef
ordered but price per pound increased
by \$3.06. Vegetable cost also increased.
DONATIONS – down by \$205.00
NET DINNER PROFIT - down by \$514.64
MEALS SERVED IN HALL – down by 11
PHONE IN ORDERS - up by 24
WALK-IN TAKE-OUTS - down by 5

In comparing the slight decrease in revenue to the fewer number of workers and food donations required it would seem that the decision to shorten the hours of the Parish Supper was a prudent and wise one.
