GOD'S WORD THIS SUNDAY

July 3, 2016—14th Sunday in Ordinary

One of the most counter-cultural parts of Christian faith is our recognition of the goodness of the human body. Our faith proclaims that God will care for our needs like a mother feeds and cares for her baby. In the second reading, Paul points out that it is not the appearance of our bodies that matters (circumcision or not), but rather that God has become human and our bodies bear witness to Jesus. When Jesus sent out His disciples, he sent them out trusting that others would provide for their hunger and thirst, shelter and warm clothing. Our physical needs in the body are signs of our need for God and each other. This week, thank God for your hunger and thirst, your longing and your grief. When you feel your own need and recognize the needs of others, thank God for the way He meets those needs, and for the privilege of helping to meet the needs of others' bodies.
