To celebrate the 100th Anniversary of the St. Francis Xavier CWL, the Council will be presenting an "**Historic Highlight**", a remembrance of each decade, which will appear once a month throughout 2021. This month's "**Highlight**" features the 1970s.

1970-1979

In the 1970's the Canadian Government increased Social Assistance payments to the underprivileged, the young and the aged in an effort to realize a social democracy. We experienced the October Crisis and martial law that followed.

The CWL sent a spiritual bouquet to Pope Paul VI during the 1975 Holy Year. Dr. Gendron addressed the Council on the topic of abortion and Father Sammon spoke on Marriage Encounter. Fathers Pat Dobec, Kerry Brennan and David Hale were ordained. The CWL convened the ordination dinners and receptions after First Mass. Approximately 100 Ladies helped cater to wedding dinners and receptions. The first Tea and Talent Sale was started in 1974. In 1978 the Council hosted a two day CWL Provincial Council Meeting with a Christian Family Life theme.

During the 1970's we started to host Birthday parties and made St. Patrick's Day table favours for the Bonnechere Manor. We purchased the stage curtains and a Mini Matic floor cleaner for the new hall.

Fees were \$1.50.
