Five years ago Pope Francis gifted Catholics with the encyclical Laudato Si, where he calls us all to action. He reminds us that we can and should cooperate as instruments of God for the care of creation, each according to his or her own culture, experience, involvements and talents. The CWL of Canada has taken this as its theme over the past two years. ST. FRANCIS XAVIER PARISH CATHOLIC WOMEN'S LEAGUE - 100TH ANNIVERSARY To celebrate the 100th Anniversary of the St. Francis Xavier CWL, the council will be presenting an "Historic Highlights", a remembrance of each decade, which will appear once a month throughout 2021. This month's "Highlight" features the 1960s.

#### 1960-1969

In the 1960's "The Canadian Bill of Rights" was enacted by Parliament of Canada. Population 18,000,000. We accepted our beloved Maple Leaf Flag and perhaps some attended Expo 67 (Canada's Centennial Year) in Montreal. Bishop Smith attends the Ecumenical Council in Rome – Vatican II. It was also the start of discontent in Canada.

The CWL compiled a Centennial Cookbook. From the proceeds \$1.00 a member was sent to the Vanier Family Institute. St Francis Xavier Church burnt December 12-13 of 1964. A new Church (built in the spirit of Vatican II) was completed and the Risen Christ figure in the Sanctuary was purchased by the CWL. Clothing was collected and shipped to the Holy Cross Sisters in Smithers, BC.

Fees were \$0.60 and there were 573 members.

The new Church was blessed June 23, 1968 by Bishop W.I. Smith.


