#### 2010-present

In 2017 Canada celebrated its 150th Anniversary (sesquicentennial) of Confederation, promoted by the Canadian government as Canada 150. We had two Prime Ministers during this time, Stephen Harper and Justin Trudeau. St. Francis Xavier CWL was busy organizing celebrations for its own 90th Anniversary in 2011, the Church's 50th Anniversary and Fr. Brennan's 40th Anniversary of his Ordination in 2018 and Fr.
