ST. FRANCIS XAVIER CEMETERY OPERATIONAL HIGHLIGHTS JANUARY 1/18 TO SEPTEMBER 30/18:

Income was \$64,478.86, up 8.5% over the same period last year, primarily because of a 37% increase in burials. Expenses were down 21.6% from last year to \$54,989.09 because we did not have to incur the tree pruning costs, nor the level of equipment maintenance costs of last year. Payroll costs were also down 9% over the period because of the later start of Spring cleanup and schedule efficiencies. This has resulted in a small operating surplus at the end of September of \$9,489.77, compared to a loss of \$10,711.56 for the same period last year.
