**Weekday Ash burials** – Registered members (of the two Renfrew Parishes plus Calabogie and Mount St. Patrick, and Parishioners of Griffith and Esmond) - \$330.00

Weekday Ash burials – Non-members - \$430.00

Weekend Ash burials - Registered members - \$530.00

Weekend Ash burials – Non- members - \$630.00

It was decided to not change pricing for Casket burials at this time. Casket burials will remain at \$650.00 from May 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup> and \$780.00 after November 1<sup>st</sup> each year.
