CEMETERY PRICE CHANGES

The Cemetery Board of Directors reviewed our price and cost structure for Ash Burials at our Cemetery during the last Board meeting. Prices were last reviewed in 2014. There will be two price categories for Ash burials:

Weekday Ash burials – Registered members (of the two Renfrew Parishes plus Calabogie and Mount St. Patrick, and Parishioners of Griffith and Esmond) - \$330.00

Weekday Ash burials – Non-members - \$430.00

Weekend Ash burials – Registered members - \$530.00

Weekend Ash burials – Non- members - \$630.00

It was decided to not change pricing for Casket burials at this time. Casket burials will remain at \$650.00 from May 1st to October 31st and \$780.00 after November 1st each year.
